RSES HandShake App Installation

Introduction

The RSES HandShake is a mobile app which is created to facilitate contact tracing and daily sign in/out. Operating the app is easy; users just need to launch the application and either scan the visitor card ID (barcode) or manually enter the name. The system will automatically record the data and push them to a SharePoint site on the ANU Office365 system.


Installation

Download and install Microsoft Power Apps on your mobile phone







Once *Power Apps* is installed, launch the app.



You will see a Welcome page asking for your sign in. Enter your ANU email address (xxxxx@anu.edu.au)

On the ANU Federation log in page, enter your Uni ID and Password and hit Sign in.





After you have successfully logged into Power Apps, you will be able to see RSES HandShake App listed. If it is not listed, search for "RSES HandShake".

If you would like to pin the RSES HandShake app on your mobile Home page and do not want to go through Power Apps to access the app, hit on the "..." icon next to the app title.

To launch the app, hit the app in the list. Allow Camera and location access for the app when asked.
